7. You can enjoy the freedom and flexibility of ham radio, as you can operate from anywhere, anytime, and with any equipment that suits your needs and preferences.

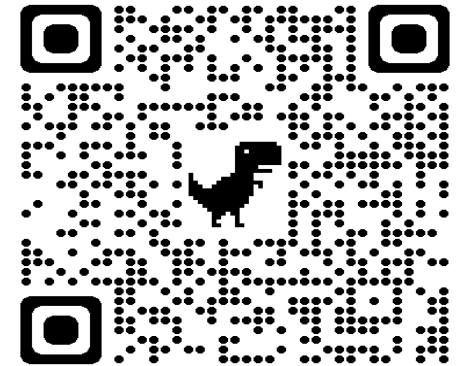
8. You can express your creativity and personality through ham radio, as you can customize your station, choose your call sign, design your QSL cards, and more.
